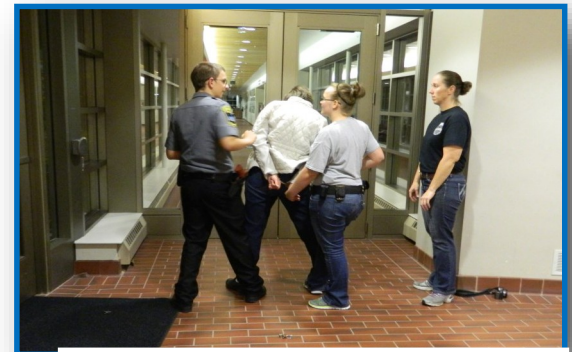
Interested In Law Enforcement?

- ◇ Build confidence, discipline, and social skills while having a great time. Teamwork and the desire to help others is emphasized.
- ◇ Gain first-hand knowledge of the challenges, duties, and job skills needed to be a police officer.

Expectations

In order to remain in good standing with the Explorer Post, members are required to:

- ◇ Attend regular meetings held on Tuesday evenings at the Lino Lakes Public Safety Department, 640 Town Center Parkway. ***These meetings are mandatory (there are exceptions for school and work)!***
- ◇ Attend metro-wide trainings held at various locations throughout the year on the 1st Saturday of the month. Explorers are strongly encouraged to attend to gain extra knowledge and to meet other explorers within the local communities.
- ◇ Participate in community events and other activities when needed such as Blue Heron Days, Night to Unite, 3M Golf Tournament and various fundraising events.
- ◇ Wear uniforms and maintain a neat and “polished” appearance at all times. You will be representing the Lino Lakes Public Safety Department.
